
many volunteers.

A MESSAGE FROM THE SWISS PARK PRESIDENT

It is still hard to believe that the Consul General office in Los Angeles is closed and the residential building on Windsor Blvd is up for sale. Need a passport? One needs to travel to San Francisco! It just feels like a big disconnect. Thomas Schneider (our short-term Consul General) was acting as the Consul General in San Francisco. Thomas has left his position and is waiting for his new assignment. Our former Consul General, Bruno Ryff, is now in the closed and now re-opened Chicago Office. Our new Consul General is Dr Benedikt Wechsler.

The Swiss Park Board has a very positive working relationship with "Heidi's World, LLC", who is operating the Banquet Center". Needed repairs on the building were closely coordinated to minimize the operation of the business. Repairs included resealing a leaky roof and a local termite treatment. The building next door was tented for termite control.

The Swiss Fair, organized by our young and dynamic Jennifer Muller, came off with flying colors. She stepped in with a lot of enthusiasm and it was a pleasure to watch her in action. A great job, Jennifer. She was supported by many volunteers. Overall, the Fair was again very successful with the slightly lower attendance. Some changes were made to improve the line for the food service, which is now under the tent, and the performers were inside the Matterhorn room. All other activities, such as cross bow

shooting, children games, soccer target shooting, secondhand store remained the same.

The Swiss Singing Harmonie gave a Concert, followed by the 1st of August message by our Consul General, Thomas Schneider.



A different flight program was introduced after the Swiss Airline stopped donating two round trip tickets. The new program was made possible by a private donation of up to \$2,000 dollars for one or two flight tickets to fly to Switzerland on any airline. The offer is good for one year. The price for the ticket(s) is refunded following the flight. The lucky winner was Peter Marty, a Member of the Swiss Athletic Society.

As always, the Swiss Fair serves as a once a year meeting place for friends who usually have little or no contact during the year. Thank you to all the volunteers and visitors.

2020 General Meeting



The **Gotthard Tunnel** is a 15.003-kilometer-long railway tunnel and forms the summit of the Gotthard Railway in Switzerland. It connects Göschenen with Airolo and was the first tunnel through the Saint-Gotthard Massif in order to bypass the St Gotthard Pass. When opened in 1882, the Gotthard Tunnel was the longest tunnel.

The new Gotthard Base Railway Tunnel opened on 1 June 2016, and full service began on 11 December 2016. With a route length of 57.09 km, it is the world's longest railway and deepest traffic tunnel and the first flat, low-level route through the Alps.

MAILAENDERLI

A popular cookie to be made for Weihnachten (Christmas Eve) but appropriate year-round.

Yields about 12 dozen

- 1 cup butter
- 4 eggs
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1 lemon, grated zest
- 1/4 lb. blanched almonds (very finely grated)
- 4 1/2 cups sifted flour
- 1 egg yolk, beaten
- 1 Tblsp. cold water



Directions: Cream butter until light and fluffy. Add eggs, one at a time, beating well after each addition. Add sugar and lemon rind, mix well. Combine the grated almonds with the butter mixture and stir in flour. Form dough into a roll and wrap in waxed paper. Place in refrigerator, allow to stand overnight. After chilled, turn onto floured board and roll 1/4 inch thick. Cut into desired shapes and place on greased

cookie sheet. Brush cookie tops lightly with combined egg yolk and cold water. Bake in a moderate oven 325° for 15 minutes or until delicately browned.


